SHARED HOUSING UPDATE for SY20-21 - Updated

If your residency status is classified as Shared Housing, which is when the parent/guardian and the student are living with relatives or friends you must update your proof of residency for SY20-21. A notarized Shared Housing Affidavit is completed on an annual basis and the required proof of residency documentation must accompany the affidavit when it is submitted to the school.

PGCPS recently transitioned to Scribbles, an online portal, to process registrations and Shared Housing updates. This is the <u>only</u> way to complete the Shared Housing procedure.

Parents must create a dashboard account, complete an enrollment application, and upload their residency documentation. Please visit https://www.pgcps.org/registration/. A Shared Housing Affidavit can be downloaded from this site.

Choose Transitioning Enrollment Option → Section G. Proof of Residency → Shared Housing Affidavit. This will provide you with the information needed to update your shared housing for SY20-21. When ready, click Register online here >> located at the top left side of the web page.

Only upload the proof of residency documents. <u>Updates must be completed by September 11, 2020 and all required documents must be submitted, no exceptions.</u>

Distance Learning UPDATES:

Parents, please update your information in Schoolmax. Your information such as address, phone number, and email must be correct in order to access student passwords, grades, etc.

Check the Perrywood or PTA websites for distance learning updates. You will continue to receive robo phone call updates and reminders.

Textbooks/Materials Distribution

The school is working on creating a team of teacher volunteers to come in and assist in preparing the items for distribution. Once the materials are received, sorted and packed, we will post the schedule for pick-up. Please understand that multiple distribution dates may be necessary; we will distribute materials as they arrive--some materials may be available prior to the start of the school year, unfortunately, some materials may arrive later.

Chromebooks Distribution

Nationally, there has been a high demand for the procurement of electronic devices, which has resulted in a delay of receiving them for PGCPS. An order has been placed and PGCPS is awaiting delivery. If your child is currently utilizing a personal device in the home, we ask that they continue to do so until the PGCPS order is processed. It is anticipated that additional devices will be available by September 21, 2020. Once received, you will be notified and a date and time will be scheduled for you to pick up a device.

Distance Learning Plan

PGCPS will start the school year with full distance learning for the first semester. Students will participate daily in a full school day of instruction with classes aligned to Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) requirements. Teachers will have the option of providing instruction from home utilizing curriculum documents and resources or using their classroom to provide instruction during the workday. Starting December 1, 2020, we will reassess the impact of COVID-19 on our state, county and school system. During this time, a parent survey will be distributed for input on the feasibility of transitioning to a hybrid learning model or maintaining the full distance learning model for the remainder of the 2020-21 school year.

Breakfast and Lunch Program

Mondays and Thursdays meal distribution, pick-up time (TBD). Lunch will also be available for purchase each day (pick up during distance learning is on Mondays and Thursdays only). If needed, please complete the Free and Reduced Meals application online. **NOTE:** Students will need to provide their pin number in order to receive meals.
